EMISSIONS INSPECTOR CERTIFICATION-E.I. C.

This course is designed by PA Dept of Transportation to provide initial certification for emissions inspectors. Class includes instruction and computer examination.

STATE SAFETY INSPECTOR CERTIFICATION

A twenty hour course that covers all of the rules, regulations, tools and procedures for the safety inspection of cars and light trucks. State required equipment and regulations are discussed along with demonstrations. Class fee includes instruction, reference manual, tool seminar, written exam tactile exam. Inspection of motorcycles is available at an additional charge and requires additional class time. Student must possess a valid driver's license and be at least 18 years old.

INDUSTRIAL WIRING FUNDAMENTALS

Textbook is required at an additional cost.

Teaches the fundamentals of electric and oxyacetylene welding and contains actual welding practice. This course is designed for those who need an understanding of how welding applies to their occupation.

Basic engine overhaul and tune-up of small gasoline engines.
